

Q5 Did you attend the CAPS Foundation Casino Royale Night on Monday evening?





Q7 If you did attend the CAPS Foundation evening, how would you rate your overall experience?







Q9 What would make you more likely to attend the Foundation Event in the future? (check all that apply)




